Displacement

- After uprooting and dispossessing the majority of the Palestinian people in 1948, Israel displaced between 100,000 and 300,000 Palestinians in 1967.
- 20,000 Palestinians are displaced every year by Israeli practices, including home demolition, expulsion, ID revocation, annexation

Replacement

 At least 620,000 Israeli settlers reside illegally in settlements built on stolen land in the West Bank, including East Jerusalem, in violation of international law

Theft of Resources

- 100% of water aquifers in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem is illegally controlled by Israel.
- Nearly 10,000 Israeli settlers living in the Jordan valley receive almost 1/3 of the water available for all 2.5 million Palestinians residing in the occupied West Bank.
- Millions of tons of stones are illegally mined from Palestinian stone every year by Israel.

Land Grab

- At least 620,000 Israeli settlers live in 250 Israeli settlements, built illegally in the occupied West Bank, including East Jerusalem, occupying and controlling roughly 60% of the territory.
- Israel has constructed an illegal Wall mostly inside the occupied West Bank. Once complete, the Wall will de facto annex up to 46% of the territory.

Mass Incarceration

- 10,000 Palestinian civilians are tried and convicted in Israeli military courts every year.
- 52,000 Palestinians have been detained without charge or trial since 1967
- 50,000 Palestinian children have been detained since 1967

Institutionalized Racism and Dehumanization

- Israel has at least 65 separate laws that specifically target and discriminate against Palestinians.
- Israeli courts have denied ALL Palestinian appeals against the demolition of their homes.
- Palestinian civilians are tried in Israeli military so-called courts that fail all tests of due process.

Criminality and Impunity

- Israeli practices and policies that entrench the colonial occupation violate international law, including international humanitarian law and international criminal law. Yet, Israel is shielded from accountability.
- Israel describes Palestinian efforts to ensure accountability under international law as "diplomatic terrorism".
- The Trump administration has threatened the ICC with sanctions if it investigates Israeli violations.
